For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this clause seeks to limit or exclude liability for personal injury or death caused by negligence.

Volunteers Liability

I understand that I am volunteering for volunteer activities at my own risk, and am responsible for my own property and safety when working on such activities.

Third Party Liability

Neither my personal representatives nor I shall bring any claim against York Cares if it is possible to bring a claim for that loss, damage, personal injury or death against any other party (including but not limited to other volunteers, landlords, property owners and local authorities).

Professional indemnity

York Cares indemnifies employee-volunteers undertaking volunteering activities which utilise their professional skills.

York Cares Discretion

York Cares retains the right in their sole discretion to consider any claim for loss and damage that is limited in value to £50.

Severance
