Social Connections

Evidence has shown that 36% of people in the UK feel lonelier since the pandemic; more than 50% want to feel more connected to their local community and 73% now recognise that a sense of community is important for wellbeing.

We have been working in partnership with City of York

Council and The Cares Family, to adapt the latter's existing proven model of intergenerational activity to suit the needs of York. By providing opportunities for younger and older people to share time, laughter, new experiences and friendship, we aim to improve people's connections and sense of belonging and therefore wellbeing.
